Subject: Retail Sale of Rice under OMSS(D) through NAFED, NCCF and Kendriya Bhandar.

Sir / Madam,

I am directed to refer to the subject mentioned above and to say that in order to check inflationary trends in food economy, it has been decided to offload 5 LMT of rice for retail sale to general consumers under 'Bharat' brand.

- 2. 2.5 LMT of rice [out of 25 LMT rice already allocated under OMSS (D)] may be offloaded in open market in the first phase for sale through NAFED,NCCF and Kendriya Bhandar.
- 3. Reserve price of rice is fixed at Rs. 24/kg and this reserve price is applicable till 31st March, 2024 or till further orders, whichever is earlier.
- 4. A further subsidy of Rs 5.41/Kg will be provided on the reserve price of Rs 24/Kg to make the effective issue price by FCI to these three Cooperative Organizations at Rs 18.59/Kg. Necessary resources to cover the differential amount will be provided to FCI from the Price Stabilization Fund of DOCA. **The approved cost sheet is at**

- 5. The organizations may make payment for rice, supplied by FCI, within 10 days from date of lifting of rice.
- 6. MRP for sale of Bharat Rice to general consumers will not exceed Rs. 29/kg.
- 7. Rice will be sold by these organizations in 5 Kg and 10 Kg Bags.
- 8. Branding of rice will be done indicating 'Bharat Chawal' in Devanagari script and 'Bharat Rice' in English on either side of the bag along with relevant vernacular translation, as needed.
- 9. As stocks of non-fortified rice are to be liquidated by 31.3.2024, FCI may ensure delivery from extant stocks of non- fortified rice as per indents placed by the three agencies.
- 10. FCI may ensure appropriate movement of stocks to deliver rice as per indents, and where this is not feasible, by accepting non-fortified CMR from millers for distribution up to 31.3.2024 under 'Bharat' brand, strictly for release against indents placed by the three agencies and within the allocation issued by DFPD.
- 11. In case of small quantities of stocks of non-fortified rice in remote, hilly areas where no indents for allocation for retail sale under 'Bharat' brand have been placed by the three agencies, the stocks may be distributed under TPDS and fully liquidated by 31.3.2024.
